1 The following is a position paper under Section 17 of the NYRA bylaws:

3 Dozens of behavior modification schools have sprung up, in this country and abroad, pledging to cure
4 teenagers of all behavior problems. These "gulag schools" use manipulative marketing to deceive
5 parents in to sending their sons and daughters there at great financial cost. Gulag school use
6 extreme methods of physical and emotional abuse that have in some cases resulted in death.

8 Teens, often having committed no crime, are abducted in the middle of the night and imprisoned for
9 months in these abusive institutions. The National Youth Rights Association believes these schools
10 are an affront to human rights and dignity and strongly seeks the total elimination of all such
11 institutions.
